Scoring teams will evaluate applications by applying the criteria to the answers provided by applicant(s). The scoring committee's decisions are final. :

Funding Process

Funding for approved grants will be awarded in October/November 2025 at the latest and will be accessed online through Class Wallet. Each grantee will receive a Class Wallet Debit Card linked to their Class Wallet account to access their project grant funds. Only the

designated lead teacher will receive access to Class Wallet for team grants. Funds must be expended by May 15, 2026. All dates will be listed on the grant acknowledgment form that must be signed by you and your principal.:
